## Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into this 9th Day of December of Two thousand nineteen between A.R. College of Pharmacy and GH Patel Institute of Pharmacy, managed by Charutar Vidya Mandal (hereinafter called ARCP), a Pharmacy College on one part.

## AND

Charutar Arogya Mandal a registered public charitable trust under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 (hereinafter referred to as CAM) Vallabh Vidyanagar – 388 120, District Anand, Gujarat on another part.

A.R. College of Pharmacy and G.H. Patel Institute of Pharmacy (ARCP) is offering a Master of Pharmacy (Two year Post Graduate Programme) in Pharmacy Practice.

Whereas the CAM has state of the art infrastructure facilities in all the aspects i.e. in terms of faculties, doctors, paramedical staff, equipments, laboratory testing facilities and having 800 bedded hospital and more then 120 beds for General Medicine. ARCP Would like to take benefit from the rich resources of CAM in offering this Master of Pharmacy programme.

Both the parties are mutually agreed for the following:

- 1. The ARCP and the CAM are signing this MoU to achieve the beneficial objectives of Pharmacy practice programmes.
- 2. The CAM will provide preceptors required to train the M.Pharm students for a period of not less than 50 hours and it will be covered in 200 working days in each year of the course.
- 3. The prospective students will be allowed to undergo training in the following specialties:
  - Medicine
  - A Surgery
  - Pediatrics
  - Gynecology and obstetrics
  - A Psychiatry
  - A Skin & VD
  - A Orthopedics





- The ARCP will responsible to provide academic staff and necessary infrastructure for pharmacy practice to the M.Pharm. student as per the PCI norms.
- 5. Both the parties shall nominate Project Co-ordinator as a single point of contact to present the ARCP Or CAM and to promote interface so as to plan, design implement, monitor and review the various activities schedule from time to time.
- 6. No financial commitment or liability from any party will be assumed unless a formal approval/acceptance to that effect has been accorded through signed documents by both the parties, ARCP And CAM. However, CAM shall get reimbursement of all the expenditure incurred in this regard, and such financial transaction will be made directly to CAM.
- 7. Any communication or notice or intimation or proceeding shall be addressed to the Project Co-ordinator of the respective parties and sent to the registered address of the parties concerned and such a communication sent by e-mail, tele-fax, registered post shall be deemed to be sufficient and acceptable.
- This MoU shall be effective from the date of signing of agreement and will be valid for a period of 10 calendar years. The validity of the MoU may be extended by mutual agreement.
- This MoU may be terminated prior to the expiry of the MoU or with one year notice by either parties and with the written consent of Principal, ARCP And Chief Executive Officer of CAM.
- 10. In case of any dispute arising out of this MoU or in any event of any terms and conditions of this MoU, the parties shall not approach any court but the question or dispute arising out of MoU shall be determined by arbitration proceedings.
- 11. The both parties will decide the detailed methodology of operation under this MoU later on and validate it by signing of both parties. Such document will be a part of this MoU.
